concerning the addition of the organizationalUnitRef attribute I agree. It is possible that different operators use the same category names and that a distinction can therefore only be made on the basis of the operator. However, we should specify which type of <organizationalUnit> is to be referenced, e.g. <railwayUndertaking> or <operationalUndertaking>. With regard to an attribute parentRef I have no general objections, but I do not yet really understand the use case. Could you give me a few simple examples, with explanations of how the attributes of the top-level categories and the subordinate categories interact?
