Dear Torben,

thank you for your feedback. I updated the Trac ticket #394 [1] with a railML 2.5 solution proposal including semantic rules for the different scenarios of usage. The rules are:

- * use @startDateTime and/or @endDateTime to specify an open or closed timespan for the state's validity that is not linked with an <operatingPeriod>
- * use @startTime and/or @endTime (and @endDayOffset) to specify an open or closed timespan for the state linked with an <operatingPeriod> where @startDate and/or @endDate are defined

Are these rules sufficient?
