>> group with a "baliseGroupRef" attribute in <signal> or <signalAspect>.

With the latest commit the new optional attribute "baliseGroupRef" has
been implemented for the <signal> element. In parallel the attribute
"signalRef" has been removed from the <baliseGroup> element.
