Hello everybody,

Am 15.03.2013 23:05, schrieb Christian Rahmig:

- > It is necessary to put the offset in a separate field. Only then it is
- > possible to distinguish between the mileage value in the gap and after
- > the gap. In particular "123.4 +1" is a different value than "123.5".
- > Therefore, I suggest to give the milepost two attributes: "shownValue"
- > given in kilometers with 3 digits behind the comma and "shownOffset"
- > given in dezi-kilometers without any digits behind the comma (e.g. 100m
- > = 1).

Susanne mentioned that this solution might be very specific for Germany. How about the situation in other countries in Europe and the world? I would like to forward this question to our international users: Please share your experiences here in the forum. Thank you.
