Hi there,

a) is there a specific reason why the "trainID" attribute of the train element in the timetable schema is of type "tGenericID", i.e.

```
<xsd:attribute name="trainID" type="tGenericID" use="required" />
```

instead of type "xs:ID"? The latter one would allow to search for (train-)elements by their ID in most DOM implementations, e.g.

```
Element element = doc.getDocumentElement().getFirstChildElement();
```

b) Where can I publicly find the most recent schema versions? A previous news entry refers to "The latest version of the timetable scheme is available on the RailML-Server. ", but I assume this is a non-public part of the server?
