Oh, now I see the point.

The "sectionTT" in version 1.1.R2 ist still the same as the "section" in 1.1. The renaming with TT should just indicate, that it is not part of the infrastructure. It is instead the usage of the infrastructure by a train (this might be a bit sophisticated). In the timetable.xsd you can see, that sectionTT is still a subelement of an "ocpTT" (= entry).

The problem is, that I made a wrong example by putting "sectionTT" on the same level than "ocpTT". The file was valid because "sectionTT" was now regarded an "any"-element and therefore still correct, so I missed this error. I'm going to modify my example, will that solve your problem?
