Hello Andreas, many thanks for your posting.

This is a good argument to get rid of the "begin/end" in the ocpType. I would vote for separate new attributes, indicating that a commercial or operational train either begins/ends or is crossing the border to somewhere outside e.g. an other country.

The ocpType has currently a mixture of two different meanings:

- stop/pass to indicate whether the train stops at this entry or passes this point
- begin/end at the first/last entry to indicate if the train is really starting/ending or just crossing the border of the examined area.

What less confusing attributes would you suggest?
